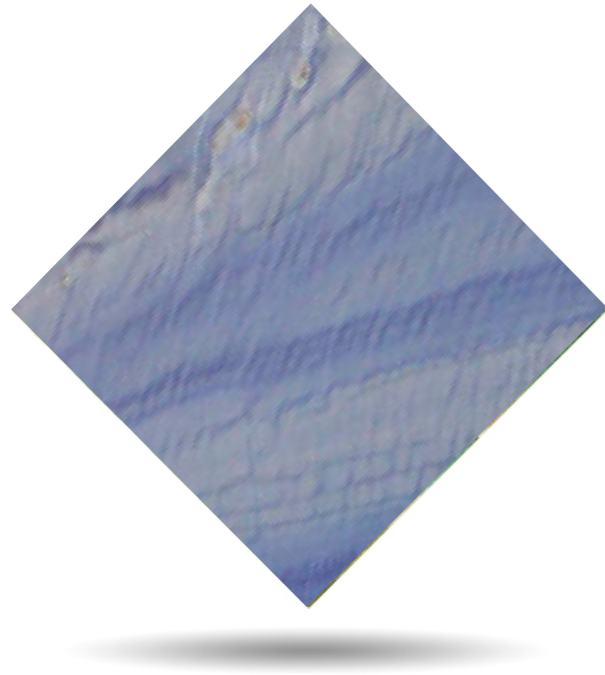


BLUE MACAUBAS

Technical Details

BLUE MACAUBAS



Macauba Blue is a blue quartzite. Its crystalline and semiprecious background oscillates between sky-blue and cobalt. It has thick glacial white veins that very occasionally incorporates some small orange striations.

This natural stone adds to its unquestionable beauty the own resistance of the quartzite, a variety of rock which is especially hard and resistant against environmental aggressions and any form of usage. Quartzite also has a low degree of porosity allowing to minimize the absorption of harmful substances or substances that can generate stains.

Architects and interior designers rely on Macauba Blue quartzite to imprint personality and differentiation using cold colors. It can be used for worktops, exterior and interior cladding, and interior flooring for high quality residential and hotel projects.



SIZES

Sizes can be adapted to each project requirements. Standard thickness is 2cm and maximum size for this thickness is 240x140cm. For other thickness check available sizes.

Dimensional tolerance limits according to standards UNE-EN 12058 and UNE-EN 1341.
